I had heard that Johnny Gunn was a good westerns writer. In TERROR ON FLAT TOP RIDGE, the second in his Terrence Corcoran series, indicates this to be true. I enjoyed NAME'S CORCORA, TERRENCE CORCORAN, the first in the series, but in this volume Gunn seems to finding his voice for this character.

Corcoran is more believable as a traditional Irish hero in the old west without resorting to caricature. The supporting characters also seem a little more fully developed, especially William “Pappy” Somerset, an elderly gentleman who scouted in his early years for the army, and Sandy McAuliffe, an “an older man with white, nicely attended whiskers that hung down to the middle of his chest and a full head of long white hair in a braid that stretched down his back.” And he has a big, well-used knife.

These old scouts share their experience and wisdom as they help lead Corcoran and his friends to follow the trail of the “bad guys.” A minor complaint I might have is that these two old scouts are a little too similar to occupy the same function in the same story.

The villains - Humboldt Charley, half Paiute and half Louisiana Cajun, and a full-time, angry man – and his gang are not just evil, but crazy evil, as they leave behind a trail of rape and murder.

Gunn still uses a stylistic device that I found somewhat distracting, because his characters seem to routinely “chuckle” throughout the story regardless of situation.

As a whole, however, this tale provides a solid westerns adventure that will surely please fans of this genre.
